

**NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

**TEMPORARY MODIFICATION TO DISINFECTION PROCESS
and
HYDRANT/WATER MAIN FLUSHING**

Ave Maria Utility Company, LLLP (AMUC) will be temporarily changing the disinfection process for the AMUC potable (drinking) water supply. From **January 8, 2016 to February 10th, 2016**, AMUC will disinfect the water with free chlorine rather than combined chlorine/ammonia (chloramines). This conversion to free chlorine (which is a stronger disinfectant) from chloramines (which is a longer disinfectant) allows AMUC to perform treatment of the water distribution as recommended by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for utilities using chloramines as their primary disinfectant.

This temporary change in disinfectant does not cause adverse health effects. However, during this period, customers may experience a change in the taste and odor of their water associated with the free chlorine.

Customers on dialysis who use a proportioning machine to prepare dialysate are advised to contact their physician to obtain the appropriate steps to accommodate the change in disinfectants. Customers who have fish tanks or aquatic species are advised to contact a professional aquarist to avoid any problems associated with the chlorine.

AMUC will also be conducting a flush of the drinking water distribution system during this time and will be intermittently flushing fire hydrants from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The flush of the distribution system will allow the free chlorine to move quickly throughout the distribution system.

Customers should be aware that they might experience short-term changes to their water quality, including cloudy or discolored water, during flushing of their neighborhood. While the water is safe to drink, it may stain clothes during washing. If customers notice any cloudy or discolored water from their faucets, they should run the water for several minutes until the water becomes clear again.
