This fact sheet is provided as a reference to encourage a greater understanding of the various issues related to managing water in South Florida.

Landscape Irrigation Restrictions *For Collier County, including the City of Naples*

- Landscape irrigation using reclaimed water is not restricted.
- Low-volume irrigation, micro-irrigation, low-volume hand watering and rain barrels, cisterns and other similar rain harvesting devices can be used at any time.

Existing landscaping

- Landscape irrigation is prohibited between 8 a.m. and midnight.
- Residents and businesses with odd-numbered addresses may irrigate only on **Wednesdays** and **Saturdays**.
- Residents and businesses with no address, or even-numbered addresses and systems that irrigate both even and odd addresses within the same zones, such as multi-family units and homeowners associations may irrigate only on **Thursdays** and **Sundays**.

New landscaping

- Landscaping that has been in place for 60 days or less may be watered Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
- An entire irrigation system zone may only be watered if it contains at least 50 percent new landscaping.
- Targeted low-volume watering of individual new plantings is allowed.

Applying lawn maintenance products

- Landscape irrigation for watering-in fertilizers, insecticides, pesticides, fungicides and herbicides is allowed for one application unless the need for more than one application is stated in the directions specified by the product manufacturer.
- Watering-in is allowed only during established watering days and times unless a professional licensed applicator has posted a temporary sign with the date of the application and the date of needed watering-in.
